Re: Year 12 return Term 4

Dear Parent/Carer

The organisation schedule for Year 12 returning in Term 4 has been attached. In 2021 the last official day for Year 12 is Friday 17th September. With the HSC examinations being moved into November, schools have been requested to provide a structure for Year 12 students for the beginning of Term 4, to support them in their preparation for the HSC examinations and (where possible) to provide opportunities for students to engage in their Year 12 milestone moments.

The HSC exams commence on Tuesday 9th November at the New Life Church - Week 6 Term 4. Through Weeks 1 – 5 there will be flexibility for when students need to attend school. Students are not required to be on school grounds in Weeks 3 and 4 if they do not have scheduled classes they can study at home. Where required students can go to the library between classes. Organisation for Year 12 students in Term 4 is as follows (please note this will depend on the public health orders that are in place at the time):

Weeks 1 and 2

Students are expected to attend all scheduled classes in Weeks 1 and 2 of Term 4 following their normal timetable (see attached schedule). Throughout Week 2 students will engage in their Year 12 farewell activities. The option of a farewell assembly is still being investigated and where possible will be coordinated following COVID guidelines at school for Year 12 students only. This is still being organised and details on this will be provided once finalised. Students are to sign in and out using the QR code on the front gate each day they attend and wear a mask at all times. Students must attend to be a part of the Year 12 farewell activities.

Weeks 3 and 4

Throughout Weeks 3 and 4, students will attend following a reduced timetable (see attached schedule). Students have the flexibility to leave school grounds between classes throughout Weeks 3 and 4 and study at home. They are not required to remain on school grounds. Students **MUST** sign in and out of school each time using the QR code and wear a mask at all times. Students can remain in the library between classes if required.

Week 5

In Week 5 students are not required to be at school as there are no scheduled classes – this is StuVac (study vacation). Students can study at home in preparation for their HSC exams and will have access to their teachers at the normal scheduled times on the timetable. Any students who are on school grounds to meet with their teachers throughout this week are to sign in and out using the QR code and wear a mask at all times.

Week 6

Tuesday 9th November the HSC examinations commence at the New Life Church (see other information note)

Life Skills Pathway

Students studying a Life Skills Pathway will receive additional information for Term 4 organisation.

It is important that students continue to engage with their teachers and the learning provided to ensure they maximise their performance for the upcoming HSC examinations.

We look forward to working with Year 12 students throughout the beginning of this term.
