## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Year 9 exam are 60 minutes in length and will be in the Hall.
- 2. Year 10 exams are 90 minutes in length and will be in the Hall.
- 3. When you are not sitting an exam, you will be in normal classes as per your timetable.
- 4. For Year 10, a non-attempt or non-serious attempt of any exam will result in an N-warning being issued for that subject.
- 5. Students are to bring all their own equipment on the day e.g. pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, scientific calculator.
- 6. Students' behaviour must adhere to 'exam conditions of silence & individual focus'. This means: No talking; No disruptive behaviour; Sitting square in chair, facing forward and/or; No gestures; hand signals or establishing communication with other students (verbal or non-verbal). Students are not allowed to get up or walk around. If you need assistance, raise your hand, and wait silently until a supervising teacher comes over to see you.
- 7. If students are disrupting an exam, they will be given one warning by having a red card placed on your desk; if a second red card is placed on desk, a zero mark will be awarded and you will be removed from the exam room, to see a Head Teacher.
- 8. Students are not permitted to have mobile phones or smart watches; they should be left in your pouch or at school office. Phones and smart watches will be confiscated, and a zero mark will be awarded.
- 9. At the end of each exam students will be supervised by the exam teachers until the end of the period (if there is time remaining until recess or lunch).
