- Minimal impact of fire. Early term 2 all will be rectified. Insurers and Assessors have seen it.
- Carpet damaged from flooding
- Admin roof reroofed due to hail damage
- Maintenance repair. Annual maintenance allocation is up to \$200,000 (an increase on last year)
- Student numbers are down. 2018 just over 600, 2019 it is around 570
- there are 96 year 7 enrolments. There is a slight drop in staffing. Staffing is difficult to fill; this is state wide.
- 2 permanent English teachers filled. Next term still various positions across faculties to fill.
- No counsellor at the moment. We are fortunate we have Care Connect and the Wellbeing Health Nurse. Di Watt, the Senior Counsellor is based at YHS.
- Library Precinct prep work is going to plan
- Minimum standards test is now not part of Naplan. They can have 2 attempts in term 2 and 4.
- 8<sup>th</sup> April 4:30pm -7pm are the Parent Teacher interviews
- Open Day was great. Very positive feedback. Steady flow of people. Suggestions were to look at opening up the art and music rooms, have some sport displays and what is going on around town.
